PLACING THE KNIFE ON OUR HEARTS

Eid ul Adha, commemorates the sacrifice of Prophet Ibrahim (Abraham peace be upon him). It is one of the most important annual events in the life of a Muslim. Its importance can be noted from the question asked in the Noble Quraan, *“And who could be of better faith than he who surrenders his whole being unto Allâh and is a doer of good and follows the creed of Ibrahim who turned away from all that is false – And Allâh chose Ibrahim as His close friend.”* (Chapter 4, Verse 125)
